New York City

Arrival and Departure

Arrival day is Thursday, May 3. Plan to arrive in New York City in time for our 5 p.m. Welcome reception in the Empire Suite of the Westin New York Times Square. LaGuardia Airport is just six miles from the hotel and there are a variety of ground transportation options available to you, including cab, Uber, Lyft, shuttle and private car.

Departure day is Sunday, May 6. You can plan your departure for any time on Sunday. Check-out time is 11 a.m.



Activities

Chelsea District Art Gallery Crawl

The City's Chelsea art district is a hub of creative activity that's best appreciated through a guided walking tour. We'll visit five of the district's 200 art galleries with curators and artists discussing their artistic vision and see the latest in contemporary art ranging from traditional paintings, drawings and sculptures to more dynamic media such as sound, video and light.

Matinee and Evening Broadway Shows

Broadway musicals are performed around the world, but there is no better place to see them shine than on the "Great White Way." You can choose what show(s) you'd like to see. We'll get you the tickets. (Ticket will be a separate charge). We'll make some suggestions, but you're in control of what you see.



The Highline Park and Whitney Museum

The Highline sits 29 feet over the meat-packing district. It is fashioned with linear-concrete-planked walkways surrounded by trees and wildflowers, a sundeck, an area for public art exhibitions, and the remnants of its past life as an elevated rail structure. The mile-and-a-half-long swath of green landscape boasts panoramic views of the Hudson and the magnificent New York City skyline. The Whitney Museum sits at the bottom of the Highline and is dedicated to collecting, preserving, interpreting and exhibiting American art and its collection—arguably the finest holding of 20th century American art in the world.



Central Park

Since 1857, the 778 acres they call Central Park has been a can't-miss site for any New York excursion. There's an almost unlimited amount of things to see and do, be it taking a quiet stroll in the Shakespeare Garden, relaxing by the Harlem Meer, or taking in the Metropolitan Museum of Art.



September 11 Memorial Park, Museum and First Responder

The National September 11 Memorial is on the site of the former World Trade Center complex. The Memorial Park surrounds two square waterfalls – the largest man-made waterfalls in North America – which cascade into reflecting pools finally disappearing into the footprints of the former Twin Towers. The names of victims who were lost in the 1993 bombing and 2001 attacks are etched in bronze around the edges of the pools.

The Museum's exhibit space is within the archaeological heart of the World Trade Center site telling the story of 9/11 through multimedia displays, archives, narratives and collections of monumental and authentic artifacts.

An associate of the New York Police Department will accompany our group and provide detailed, intimate knowledge of the 9/11 attacks on the World Trade Center.



Lower East Side Tasting Tour

Often wonder where all the teeming masses landed after passing through Ellis Island? The Lower East side is the melting pot of today's and yesterday's New York immigrants. Filled with sights and sounds, and smells of ethnic cooking this tour features the cultures as well as the cuisine of our ancestors. Savor samples of knish or kosher dill on Orchard Street, dim sum in Chinatown and cannoli in Little Italy.
