



Thursday, October 1

Arrive at Montrose Airport where you will be greeted and transported to the Hotel Columbia in historic Telluride.

After arriving and settling in we'll go to the Sheridan Opera House for cocktails and our first screening followed by dinner at the Chop House at the New Sheridan.

Friday, October 2

We'll start the day with breakfast and conversation. Then it's a short walk to The Nugget Theater for a collection of documentaries followed by lunch at a local restaurant.

In the afternoon the Steinbacks will lead us on an easy hike through town to the Bridal Veil waterfalls.

In the evening we'll head back to the Sheridan Opera House for screenings and then dinner.

Saturday, October 3

After breakfast and conversation, we'll experience Telluride's fabulous high country while learning the history of one the world's most famous and notorious gold rush towns. Or you can join local historian Ashley Boling for a town tour followed by shopping.


After lunch we'll head back to the Nugget Theater for more inspirational and thought-challenging documentaries.

Note: Telluride's altitude is 8,750 feet. Mountain Village where we will have dinner on Saturday is at 10,551 feet and the 4x4 tour will reach 13,000 feet. If you have issues with adjusting to altitude we advise arriving early to help your body adjust and drinking plenty of water before and during your trip.

Nestled in a box canyon surrounded by the 14,000-foot San Juan Mountains and overflowing with local character is the Victorian mining town of Telluride, Colorado, a National Historic Landmark District. The European-style, alpine Mountain Village is perched just above Telluride and connected by a three-stage gondola system. The fast and free ride offers glorious vistas of the surrounding mountains.
